\*NOTE: 4-STROKE HORSEPOWER DIFFERENTIALS ARE TAKEN UP BY WEIGHT. EG: BRIGGS LIGHT (RAPTOR – 315#, ANIMAL – 325#, WF – 335#)

**No drop races. Driver must compete in 4 races for your accumulated points to be eligible for championship. Classes must have a 1.7 average entry at end of season for it to be a championship class and awards eligible. Eg: This is a 7 race series so any class must have a total of 12 entries to be an eligible class. Will have scales at random races, so be honest and make sure your entry meets the class minimum weight post race. See applicable rules per class above.**

**Registration begins at 8:00 AM and controlled practice at 8:15 AM. Registration closes at 10:55 AM. Drivers meeting at 11:00 AM with qualifying heat races starting immediately after. All races will be a two heat qualifier and feature format with starting position for qualifier heat determined by a draw. Finishing order of feature pays all the points. Must obtain an armband and be registered in a class by close of registration or you must start in back for heat race. All drivers and crew must sign waiver, pay fee and obtain arm band. If you do not pay then you subject your driver to disqualification and loss of points. No spectator fees will be required as we simply cannot control the spectator area as of yet.**

**Race director will be David Courtney. All rulings and/or technical decisions including disqualification will be decided by David and will be final.**
